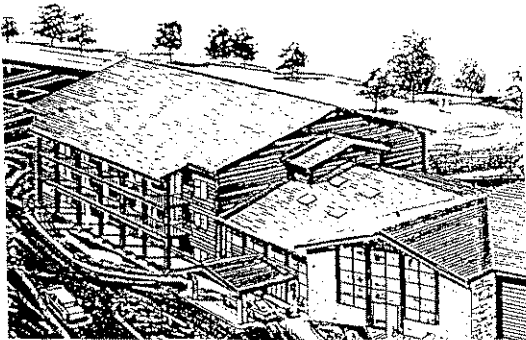

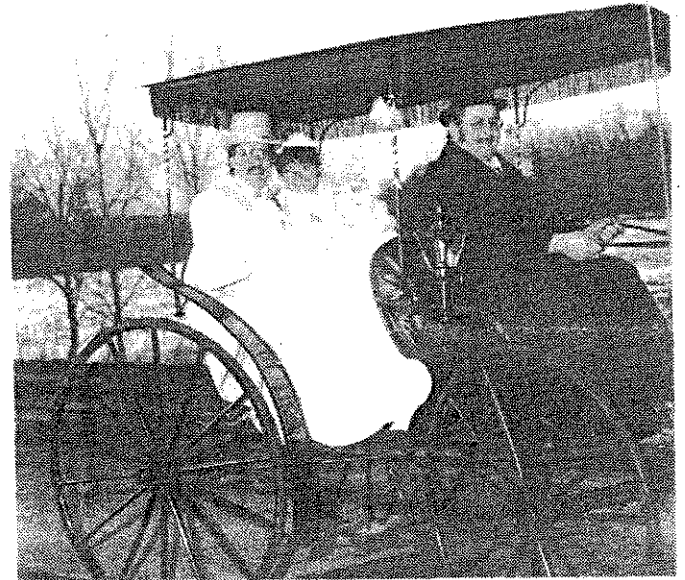
CANCER SOCIETY HOLDS DAFFODIL BALL

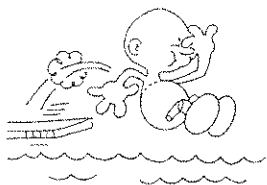

The planners are also considering "Shotgun Starts" for the leagues which will enable everyone to start and finish together.

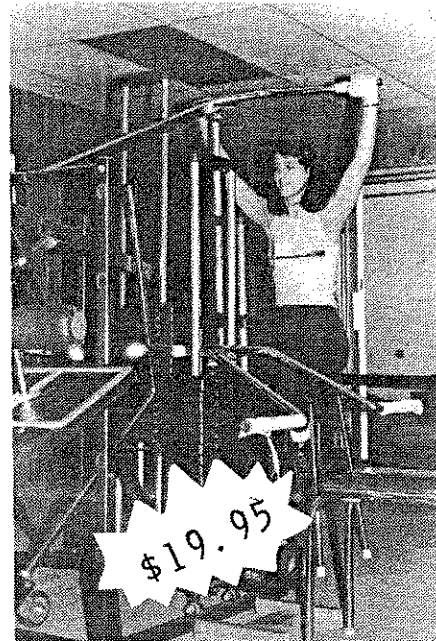
Everyone interested is invited to attend the organizational meeting to be held at the Lodge on April 10th at 7:00 pm.
